- Brucellosis (*Brucella abortus*)
- Campylobacteriosis

- Colibacillosis (*Escherichia coli*)
- Cryptosporidiosis
- Cysticercosis
- Dermatophilosis (rain scald)
- Dermatophytosis (ringworm)
- Echinococcosis
- Giardiasis
- Leptospirosis
- Listeriosis
- Mites-Mange (acariasis)
- Pseudocowpox
- Q fever
- Rabies
- Salmonellosis
- Streptococcosis
- Vesicular stomatitis
