AVOID

FOR PEOPLE

Avoid disease vectors

- Mosquitoes, ticks, and fleas can transfer diseases from animals to people
- Avoid vector areas (tall grass, wooded areas) and peak activity times (dusk,dawn)

Avoid wild animals

 Wild animals can transfer diseases to your animals and to you

FOR PETS

Avoid disease vectors

 Have your pet checked by your veterinarian for external parasites (e.g., ticks, fleas)

Avoid wild animals

 Keep pets away from wild animals





FOR LIVESTOCK/POULTRY

Avoid disease vectors

- Check animals for external parasites (e.g., ticks, mites, lice)
- Implement vector control programs on your farm

Avoid wild animals

- Reduce contact with wildlife (e.g., feral swine, deer, waterfowl)
- Keep scavengers (e.g., rodents, birds) out of animal feed and areas
