Prevent Zoonoses



Remember W.A.S.H.

WASH

FOR PEOPLE

Keep germs out of your eyes, nose, and mouth --

Wash your hands often with soap and water!

Especially

- AFTER contact with pets, livestock or poultry
- AFTER contact with pet food and treats, toys, or animal bedding
- AFTER cleaning up poop, manure or cleaning cages
- BEFORE contact with infants or young children
- BEFORE preparing or eating food

FOR PETS

Clean pet areas regularly

- Clean litter boxes daily
- Pick up pet waste in the yard weekly
- Clean and disinfect reptile and rodent cages at least weekly
- Clean the lining of bird cages daily

FOR LIVESTOCK/POULTRY

Keep germs out!

- Wear clean clothing and footwear into animal areas
- Remove manure and soiled bedding frequently
- Clean and disinfect equipment/objects/vehicles used in animal areas
